Since October 2020, WORLD has partnered with Alameda County Health Services Agency to deliver care kits to households with a member in isolation due to a COVID diagnosis.

This program is a bit different for WORLD as it is not available for WORLD clients (you can access personal protective equipment by contacting your peer
