Who is the Leadership Institute for?

The Leadership Institute is for women and girls living with HIV across the state of California who have a desire to be an advocate, community leader and/or go into politics and serve their community, including sitting on planning councils, commissions, and giving a voice to those who are still working to find theirs.

What is the WORLD Leadership Institute (WLI)?

The WORLD Leadership Institute (WLI) consists of eight 2-hour training sessions, delivered by trained facilitators, including an orientation and graduation. The WLI will take HIV-positive women on a journey from Acknowledgment & Acceptance to Empowerment and Leadership while addressing the following topics:

I: Orientation: Laying the Foundation II: My Backstory III: What Does Advocacy, Leadership and Being a Leader Entail? IV: What is the Difference between Local, State and National Advocacy? V: How Do You Get a Policy Enacted? VI: How Do You Plan an Event? VII: I Am a Leader in the Community, Now What? VIII: Graduation

When will the WLI take place?

The WORLD Leadership Institute will take place twice a year, once in the Spring and once in the Fall. Where will the WLI take place?

Training sessions will take place via Zoom with a stipend and technology gift for all graduates.
